

## Parents Q&A

### What will kids do during the celebration worship service?

Just like each Sunday in Lexington, we will have optional children's activities during the full worship service for the little ones, from birth to pre-K. There's also an optional children's worship during the sermon portion of the worship service for children in Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Kids grade 3 and older stay with their parents. After the service, all kids will be with their parents for the celebration lunch.

### What are the age ranges for the children in each area?

The nursery area (comprised of 3 rooms) is for newborns, sitters, crawlers and those beginning to walk. The ladies assisting in check-in can help you find the best room for your child.

The preschool area (comprised of 6 rooms) is for toddlers through pre-K. The ladies helping families check-in in that area can help you find the best room for your child. In this area, you will also see birth date ranges on a sign above each door.

### Where do I go to check-in my kids?

Babies, toddlers, and preschoolers need to be checked in at any of three check-in stations located in our nursery foyer and preschool foyer. The ladies there can assist you to get a nametag for your child, a security tag for parents, and answer any questions you may have.

Children in Kindergarten – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade who are participating in the optional children's worship don't need to check in at the computers, and can meet their leaders just before the sermon begins at the back of the worship center. You'll see a dismissal slide that comes up just before the sermon. They will go as a group to the elementary area (room 163), located on the other side of the family center.

### What do I need to do to pick up my child after the service before the lunch?

Parents can pick up children directly from their rooms. For the little ones, simply present the security tag to those ministering to the children in that room. For Kindergarten-2<sup>nd</sup> grade, parents can pick them up at the elementary meeting area.
